

## INTERMEDIATE APPRENTICESHIP

### CHILDCARE

This qualification has been designed to help apprentices build the knowledge and skills required to work with children and young people from birth to 19 years. Covering a range of job roles and occupational areas within childcare settings, this qualification is aimed at those who work or wish to work in a supervised position. For apprentices who want to undertake more challenging study this course includes optional units from the Level 3 Diploma. Apprentices must complete 11 mandatory units and a selection of optional units to achieve the qualification.

#### MANDATORY UNITS INCLUDE:

- Introduction to communication in health, social care or children and young people's settings
- Introduction to equality and inclusion in health, social care or children and young people's settings
- Child and young person development
- Safeguarding the welfare of children and young people
- Support positive children and young people's behaviour

#### QUALIFICATION INCLUDES:

- Level 2 Children and Young People's Workforce
- Functional Skills in Maths, English and ICT at Level 1 or 2 (depending on prior qualifications)
- ERR (Employer Rights and Responsibilities)

#### TRAINING:

- One-off induction
- Monthly college workshops or work-based supported learning
- On-the-job assessments
- Employer led work related skills training

#### SUITABLE FOR:

Those who are interested in working with children in a supervised position.
