

INTERMEDIATE APPRENTICESHIP

SUPPORTING TEACHING AND LEARNING

The Intermediate Apprenticeship covers a wide range of topics including children and young people's development, supporting those with disabilities, special educational needs and communication, and professional relationships. This qualification is designed to help apprentices gain the skills and knowledge required when supporting teaching and learning in primary, secondary or special schools. Apprentices must complete 11 mandatory units to achieve the qualification.

MANDATORY UNITS INCLUDE:

- Understand schools and colleges as organisations
- Understand children and young people's development
- Safeguarding children and young people
- Maintain relationships with children
- Promote effective learning environment
- Support positive behaviour in a learning environment for children and young people

QUALIFICATION INCLUDES:

- Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning
- Functional Skills in Maths, English and ICT at Level 1 or 2 (depending on prior qualifications)
- ERR (Employer Rights and Responsibilities)

TRAINING:

- One-off induction
- Monthly college workshops or work-based supported learning
- On-the-job assessments
- Employer led work related skills training

SUITABLE FOR:

Those who are new to working in a school as a Teaching Assistant.
