

ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIP

SUPPORTING TEACHING AND LEARNING

The Advanced Apprenticeship is designed for those with a wider range of responsibilities, working on their own or as part of a team. It covers a variety of areas including children and young people's development, supporting those with disabilities or special education needs and communication and professional relationships. Apprentices must complete 16 mandatory units to achieve the qualification.

MANDATORY UNITS:

- Schools and colleges as organisations
- Understand how to safeguard children and young people
- Understand how children and young people develop
- Support positive behaviour in children and young people
- Understand how to support learning of children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities
- Support children and young people during learning activities

QUALIFICATION INCLUDES:

- Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Supporting Teaching and Learning
- Functional Skills in Maths, English and ICT at Level 1 or 2 (depending on prior qualifications)
- ERR (Employer Rights and Responsibilities)

TRAINING:

- One-off induction
- Monthly college workshops or work-based supported learning
- On-the-job assessments
- Employer led work related skills training

SUITABLE FOR:

Those who have completed the Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning or those who have been working as a teaching assistant for some time.

DURATION: 14 months
