Research a photographer from www.magnumphotos.com and choose a photograph that uses one of the following compositional techniques:

- Rule of Thirds
- Fibonacci Spiral
- Balancing Elements
- Leading Lines
- Symmetry and Pattern
- Viewpoint

Write a definition for your chosen compositional technique and **five** sentences on what you find interesting about the chosen technique within the photograph.

Produce one shoot (30 – 40 images) and pick out the best **six** photographs that show your use of the compositional techniques listed above.

Pick and review an article that you find interesting from one of the following websites:

What you find interesting about the article? What do you think of the photographs? Do any of the photographers apply any of the composition techniques you have researched? Which is your favourite photograph from the article and why?
