

16-19 Tuition Funding Statement

The Henley College is glad to announce receipt of additional funding to support students who are re-sitting GCSE English and GCSE mathematics qualifications as part of their programmes of study at the College. The fund has been made available by the Department for Education (DfE), to enable English and mathematics study support for GCSE English, GCSE mathematics, Functional Skills English and Functional Skills mathematics students as part of the recovery from the impact of the coronavirus pandemic. The DfE recognises the importance of English and mathematics as key study skills students need, in order to progress in education and employment. The College will use the additional funding to provide additional GCSE and Functional Skills English and mathematics workshops, and additional 1:1 study support in English and mathematics for students who are identified as vulnerable or 'at risk' of not engaging in learning, and students who have special educational needs and disabilities.

The College is glad to receive the funding needed to begin the recovery from the coronavirus crisis and provide additional support for students taking GCSE and Functional Skills qualifications in English and mathematics.
